THE SPIDER DESTROYER is an effective product to control spiders around the house.

DIRECTIONS: (5 mL = 1 teaspoonfuls) (15 mL = 1 tablespoonfuls). Spiders are not insects even though many people regard them as such. Spiders are predacious creatures, feeding on insects and other spiders. They obtain their food in two fashions namely by hunting or snaring their prey in silken webs. Upon entrapment spiders inject their prey with an immobilizing poison and proceed to feed on the victim's bodily fluids. Spiders do not eat solid

portions of food. Many people find spiders offensive and they can be a nuisance by constructing their webs around the home.

SPIDER CONTROL OUTDOORS: Mix 50 mL with 1 litre of water and apply as a coarse spray under eaves troughs, along siding, underneath porches or wherever spider congregate. Treatment of the webs will improve the results. The spider destroyer may stain some materials. Test a small area before proceeding. SPIDER CONTROL INDOOR: Mix 50 mL with 1 litre of water and *Apply as a spot treatment with a low pressure coarse spray or with a paint brush to localized areas only i.e., along base boards, behind fixtures, beneath and sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; around plumbing and other utility installations, around doors and windows. A spot is an area no larger than 0.2 m². NOTE: CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN TO AVOID DEPOSITING THE PRODUCT ONTO SURFACES WHICH ARE EASILY ACCESSIBLE BY CHILDREN.

Where spiders are a problem. Repeat if reinfestation occurs, but no more than once every 2 months. DO NOT APPLY AS A SPACE SPRAY. The spider destroyer may stain some materials. Test a small area before proceeding. NOTE: Do not use on roses, azaleas, camelias, poinsettias, geraniums, oxalis, coleus and variegated ivy.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid inhaling spray mist or contact with eyes, skin and clothing. May cause irritation to skin or eyes. Wash thoroughly after use. **A**Wear rubber gloves when mixing and applying the product[@] and Avoid contamination of food, feed, utensils drinking water or any body of water. Wash contaminated food surfaces, utensils and clothing with soap and water. Do not permit children or pets to contact sprayed areas until dry. Do not use in poultry houses or other animal buildings. This product is toxic to fish and crustaceans. KEEP CHILDREN AND PETS AWAY FROM TREATED AREA DURING APPLICATION AND UNTIL DRY.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container, triple rinse container into sprayer and dispose of empty container with household garbage.

FIRST AID: IF SWALLOWED, do not induce vomiting, contains petroleum distillate solvent. IF INHALED remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Obtain medical attention or contact poison control centre. If on skin, wash with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing. If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes and obtain medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Contains a cholinesterase inhibitor and a solvent. Atropine is an antidote.
