DIRECTIONS: Wilson Earwig Destroyer is in easy-to-use granular form to be used directly from this container to make bait stations.

Wilson Earwig Destroyer contains ingredients to attract earwigs, sowbugs, crickets, cutworms, sap beetles, wood roaches and millipedes. Place one or two tablespoonfuls of product in mounds in covered bait stations around building foundations, under porches and shrubbery, or throughout vegetable, fruit or flower gardens wherever earwigs or other listed insects are seen. Cover with a flat stone, board or weighted foil plate to improve the attractiveness of the bait station and to protect its contents from pets and children.

For best results, set out bait stations in the evening and moisten bait slightly. Baits are effective for up to ten days.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS. Hazardous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Wash hands thoroughly after use with soap and water. Do not contaminate feed, food, ponds or streams.

FIRST AID: Carbaryl is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If swallowed, induce vomiting and go to hospital. Atropine is antidotal. Wrap and dispose of used container with regular garbage.
