# READ THE LABEL BEFORE USING

PATORAN (R) 50WP is contained inside this bag in a "Water Soluble Bag".

Fill tank 1/4 full with water, peel open the outer package at the top, then drop the inner water soluble bag directly into the spray tank. (See diagram) Do not touch it with wet gloves. Do not open water soluble bag. (Not for Resale) Store in dry location.

WEEDS SUPPRESSED: Barnyard Grass Witchgrass Crabgrass Annual Bluegrass Green Foxtail

MIXING AND SPRAYING INSTRUCTIONS: Spray Pressure: 200 - 300 kPa Spray Volume: 170 - 350 L of water per hectare Mesh Size: 16 mesh suction screen 50 mesh in-line and tip screens

- 1. Fill the sprayer tank 1/4 full with water. Start gentle agitation. Keep by-pass line on or near bottom of the tank to minimize foaming.
- 2. Add Patoran 50WP to the spray tank by peeling the outer package at the top, then drop the inner bag(s) into the sprayer tank. Do not touch inner bag with wet gloves (see diagram on front panel). Allow six (6) minutes for complete mixing.
- 3. Fill tank 9/10 full of water and then add Dual (R), if necessary.
- 4. Complete filling the sprayer and maintain gentle agitation while mixing and spraying.
- 5. Do not let tank contents stand without agitation. If spraying is interrupted, thoroughly re-agitate before resuming application.
- 6. Spray equipment should be thoroughly flushed with clean water and drained before and after use of Patoran 50WP.

# APPLICATION INFORMATION:

# PRE-EMERGENT APPLICATION

- Apply after planting but prior to emergence of crop and weeds.
- After treatment leave the soil undisturbed for as long as possible.
- Apply evenly to a lump- and trash-free, firm seedbed.
- Can be applied as an overall spray or as a band treatment.
- For band application, mount a suitable press wheel ahead of nozzle to level the band and use proportionately less material.
- Patoran can be applied alone or in combination with Dual (tank mix or sequential applications). Consult the Dual label for precautions, warnings, restrictions, mixing and spraying instructions and detailed directions for use.
- Rainfall (1-2 cm) is required to activate Patoran 50WP.
- A shallow cultivation or rotary hoeing will control weed escapes and

move Patoran into moist soil.
 Minimize exposure of untreated soil when cultivating.

CAUTIONS: Do not apply Patoran 50WP to soils with less than 2% organic matter or soils containing more than 70% sand. Do not apply Patoran 50WP to crops that have emerged. Heavy rainfall after application may cause damage to beans as Patoran 50WP can leach into the root zone or "splash-up" onto seedling plants. Rotary hoeing 2-3 days after application will break up crusted soil and minimize the risk of crop injury. Beans should be planted at least 4 cm deep.
