DIRECTIONS: Crawling Insects, such as: Cockroaches, Ants, Silverfish, Carpet Beetles: Apply with a paint brush, or as a coarse spray to infested areas. Thoroughly treat cracks, crevices, along baseboards, moist areas such as spaces around water pipes and tanks, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, and storage areas, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and around garbage storage areas.

Apply to ant trails, around window and door frames, sills, and

along baseboards adjacent to them. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices.

Do not use as a space spray.

Solvent used in this product is a petroleum distillate, which may stain or damage certain plastic, rubber, and asphalt materials such as tiles and floor coverings.

Do not apply to rugs, carpets, draperies, wallpaper or similar materials that may be stained.

Apply with caution to surfaces outlined and avoid excessive wetting. Good sanitary practices should be maintained to prevent re-infestation.

PRECAUTIONS: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, clothing and avoid inhalation of vapours or spray mist. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating, drinking, etc. Keep Out Of The Reach Of Children. Do not apply to plants, animals or humans. Remove pets and fishbowls from area before treatment and do not return them for at least 4 hours after treatment. Do not apply to surfaces that children or pets might contact.

DO NOT CONTAMINATE FOODSTUFFS. Do not use in any area where food may be exposed. Do not use in bulk food storage areas. Do not use in cupboards where food or cooking utensils are stored.

In homes or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed food and cooking utensils before spraying. Thoroughly wash all surfaces that might contact food before reuse.

TOXICOLOGY: Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. Obtain medical attention immediately, taking the pesticide container with you.

If on skin, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with water for 5-10 minutes and obtain medical attention.
