DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Food processing plants: For general premises disinfection of floors, walls and equipment, use 225 mL of AMINO GERM per 100 L of water.

Farms: As a disinfectant of stables, farm instructions and equipment, chicken and other poultry houses and hog houses, use 30 mL per 10 L of water.

AMINO GERM is effective against gram-positive and gram-negative bacteria. AMINO GERM effectiveness is reduced in the presence of soap.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Danger - Corrosive to the eyes. This product is poison if swallowed. All food contact surfaces require a final rinse with potable water following disinfection with AMINO GERM.
