DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 50 mL of pool algaecide H2O 40% per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 2. Maintenance dosage is 25 mL per 10,000 L every two weeks.
- 3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
- 4. For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 125 mL of pool algaecide H2O 40% per 10,000 L.
