DIRECTIONS

Place baits in locations where rats, mice and other small rodents feed, water, and/or travel. Bait placement should be made in covered bait stations along walls in corners and concealed locations, where rats and mice can feed unobserved are desirable. Contaminated or spoiled baits should be replaced promptly. PROTECT BAIT AGAINST ACCESS OF CHILDREN, PETS, LIVE STOCK AND WILDLIFE.

FOR MICE

Each station should contain at least 25 grams to 100 grams of bait. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of bait in stations which

should be placed every 2 to 3 metres for at least 15 days.

FOR RATS

Each station should contain at least 100 grams to 200 grams of bait. Maintain a constant supply of bait at stations which should be placed every 2 to 4 metres for at least 10 days.

PRECAUTION

This bait contains Chlorophacinone which if taken accidentally by humans, domestic animals or pets, may reduce clotting time of the blood and hemorrhage may result.

FIRST AID

In case of accidental indigestion give a tablespoon of salt in warm water, and repeat until vomits is clear. CALL A PHYSICIAN immediately.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

When a human has been known to have accidentally taken Chlorophacinone baits, blood transfusions combined with intravenous injections and oral doses of Vitamin K₁ are indicated as in cases of hemorrhage caused by overdoses of Dicumarol.
