DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

The product is for use by veterinarians in vet clinics and not for direct use by their clientele. Wear rubber gloves and protective gown and eyewear when using this product.

Sarcoptic Mange on Dogs:

Sarcoptic mange on dogs is characterized by loss of hair, thickened skin and intense itching, caused by the mite *Sarcoptes scabiei* var *canis*. Mix 30 mL Paramite with 3.8 litres water. Dip dog until skin is wet and allow to shake dry. Do not rinse. If mange mites reinfest dog, retreatment may be necessary.

Fleas and Ticks on Dogs:

Mix 30 mL Paramite with 3.8 litres water. Dip or sponge on solution until skin is wet. For maximum residual control, allow to dry on animal. Do not retreat under 30 days.

PRECAUTIONS:

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Wear rubber gloves when using this product. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before re-use.

Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within seven days before or after treatment with, or exposure to, other cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals. Do not treat sick or debilitated animals. Do not treat dogs under 8 weeks of age. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs. Toxic to fish. Keep out of streams, lakes, ponds and other fish-bearing waters. Do not use on nursing females. For use on pregnant animals consult veterinarian.

FIRST AID:

If Inhaled - Remove to fresh air. Keep airways open. Use artificial respiration, if necessary.

If Ingested - Induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Consult a physician immediately. Wash skin of material and vomitus. Save suspected agent and vomitus if container is available, for disposal by physician.

If In Eyes - Flush eyes with clean water for at least 15 minutes. Consult a physician immediately.

If On Skin - Wash immediately with soap and water. If irritation develops, consult a physician.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Paramite is an organophosphorous insecticide and, hence, is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. Usual symptoms of organophosphorous poisoning in man include: headache, blurred vision, weakness, nausea, discomfort in the chest, vomiting, abdominal cramps, diarrhea, salivation, sweating, pin-point pupils. Usual symptoms of organophosphorous poisoning in animals include salivation, labored breathing, stiffness, muscle tremors, ataxia, and partial or complete paralysis of hind quarters.

STORAGE:

Protect from freezing. Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not store near feed or foodstuffs. Store unused product in original, tightly sealed container.

DISPOSAL:

- (1) Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to treatment solution.
- (2) Follow Provincial Instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
- (3) Make the empty container unsuitable for further use. Never re-use!
- (4) Dispose of the container in accordance with Provincial requirements.
- (5) For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the clean-up of spills, contact the regional office of Conservation and Protection, Environment Canada.
