DIRECTIONS FOR USE

APPLICATION:

1735 is used to control algae, bacteria, and slime in recirculating commercial and industrial water cooling towers. It is particularly effective against sulphate reducing bacteria.

PROCEDURE:

Prior to the use of 1735 in cooling towers, systems should be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slime and other deposits. Then make an initial feed of 2 litres per 1000 litres of water content of the system until control is achieved. Maintenance feed 200 to 500 mL per 1000 litres. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water cooling towers. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem.

5. For small spills, recover free liquid. Soak up residue with solids absorbent. Do not flush into surface streams. Inform Environment Canada as in #4.
