SOIL TREATMENT

ONTARIO: Band treatment at planting: Apply BIRLANE INSECTICIDE 10% GRANULES with a planter mounted insecticide applicator. Use a spreader attachment to apply Birlane in a 15 cm band just in front of the press wheel. On Max-Emerge planters use a spring-tooth attachment or a drag chain mounted behind the press wheel to lightly incorporate Birlane. To avoid wind drift, mount the spreaders as close to the ground as possible or use covers to surround the spreaders.

Emergency treatment after planting: Apply Birlane Insecticide 10% Granules in a 15 to 20 cm band at the base of the corn plants and incorporate product lightly into the soil. Apply at the same rate as with band treatment at planting. This treatment must be made before the end of June to be of value. COLE CROPS (cabbage, cauliflower, Brussels sprouts, broccoli) - Cabbage maggot	
SOIL TREATMENT BRITISH COLUMBIA - Apply 175 gm of BIRLANE INSECTICIDE 10% GRANULES per 100 row-metre in a 20 cm band at the time of transplanting with the plants set down the centre of the band.
