GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

COOLING TOWER SYSTEMS: Before using AQUA-BIO II microbiocide, industrial and commercial cooling tower systems must be cleaned to remove existing algae growth, bacterial slimes, and other deposits. Then apply an initial dose of 0.5 to 1.0 litres of AQUA-BIO II microbiocide per 10,000 litres of recirculating water to provide a concentration of 50 to 100 ppm of AQUA-BIO II.

Repeat this initial dose until control is evident. Subsequent doses of 0.125 to 1.0 litres of AQUA-BIO II (12.5 to 100 ppm) per

10,000 litres of water in the system should be applied every 2 to 5 days or as needed. The frequency of dosage depends upon the relative rate of bleedoff and the severity of the microbial contamination. The dosage should be introduced into the tower sump.
