DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- . For best distribution, dilute ALGAECIDE in pail of water and pour around pool. Vacuum to remove dead algae.

- 1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 80 mL of ALGAECIDE per 10,000 L of pool water.

- 2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 30 mL per 10,000 L.

- 3. For pool water having visible algae, super-chlorinate and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage. Follow label instructions of superchlorination product employed.

- 4. For visible algae, when superchlorination product is not employed, add 120 mL of ALGAECIDE per 10,000 L.
