WEEDS CONTROLLED: Black Medick, Burdock, Chickweed, Clover, Dandelion, English Daisy, Heal-all, Lamb's Quarters, Wild Morning Glory, Mustard, Pigweed, Plantain, Ragweed, Narrow leaf Plantain, Sandwort, Shepherd's Purse.

These more resistant weeds may require repeat applications: Bindweed, Buttercup, Cinquefoil, Creeping Charlie, Fleabane, Knotweed, Round Leaf Mallow, Ox-eye Daisy, Purslane, Speedwell, Stonecrop, Thistle.

DIRECTIONS: Apply with the hand trigger sprayer attached. Depress button top and adjust nozzle to suitable spray pattern.

Apply over 20 m² of lawn or use for spot treating individual weeds.

Apply in May, June or September when weeds are growing actively. Do not apply in excessively hot or dry weather or when rain is expected. Do not apply to newly seeded lawns until after 3rd mowing. Do not water lawn for 24 hours after use. Use only as a spot treatment on bentgrasses.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING: Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant (e.g., rubber) gloves.

OPERATOR USE PRECAUTIONS: Rinse gloves before removal. Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet. If pesticide penetrates clothing, remove immediately; then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water, then shower. Reuse gloves for pesticide application only.

RE-ENTRY INTERVAL: Do not allow people (other than the applicator) or pets on the treatment area during application. Do not enter treated areas until spray has thoroughly dried.

MAXIMUM APPLICATION FREQUENCY: For good lawn management, normally two applications per year per treatment site are adequate. This does not include spot treatments.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid spray drift onto ornamental plants, fruits, vegetables.

FIRST AID: **If in eyes**, flush with water and get medical attention or contact a poison control centre IMMEDIATELY. **If on skin**, wash with soap and water. **If swallowed**, get medical attention or call a poison control centre IMMEDIATELY. Take the container, label or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap in newspaper and dispose of empty container with household garbage.

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
