SPRING START-UP

1. Adjust pH with EASY-UP or EASY-DOWN.
2. SHOCK-treat pool water with SHOCK.
3. Adjust stabilizer level with POOL STABILIZER.

TEST	PROPER LEVEL
pH -	7.2 - 7.8 - preferably 7.4 - 7.6
Chlorine -	1.0 - 1.5 ppm - pools over 50,000 litres 1.0 - 3.0 ppm - pools under 50,000 litres
Stabilizer -	25 ppm - 75 ppm

SUMMER REGULAR CARE:

1. Test daily for pH and Chlorine.
2. Chlorinate daily with PUCKS, FAST-TABS or STA-CHLOR.
3. SHOCK-treat every 7 days with SHOCK.
4. Add 4LG or ALGON 12 hours after SHOCK-treatment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

1. Chlorinate by adding one FAST-TAB per 50,000 litres per day.
2. Place in skimmer basket with pump running.
3. Adjust dosage to maintain a chlorine level of 1.0 to 3.0 ppm.
4. DO NOT USE IN AUTOMATIC CHLORINATORS.
5. Hot weather, heavy rain, a windstorm, or an usually large number of swimmers may cause demand for additional FAST-TABS to maintain the desirable 1.0 to 3.0 ppm chlorine level.
