DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

OILFIELD APPLICATIONS:

Inject continuously at 100 ppm active ingredient based on the water content of system until control is achieved. Maintenance dosage 10-25 ppm.

PAPER MILLS:

CHIMTOX 920. Solution should be used at 0.6-1.0 Kg per tonne of dry paper produced at least once per day. Not for use in the production of paper or paper board that will come into contact with food.

HEAT EXCHANGERS, COOLING TOWERS, CONDENSERS, AIR WASHERS:

Pre-clean heavily fouled systems (e.g. with Chlorine). Shock dosages of 100 ppm active ingredient based on under content of the system. Maintenance dosage: 10-25 ppm.

METAL WORKING FLUIDS:

CHIMTOX 920. Solution should be injected at 5-10 Kg per 1000 litres of system volume.

PRESERVATIVE:

CHIMTOX 920. Solution should be used in the rate of 2-10% for bacterial control in Latex Emulsions, Polymer Latices, Adhesives.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact with skin or eyes, give prolonged irrigation with water. In case of ingestion, wash out the mouth thoroughly with water and give water to drink. In all cases obtain medical attention.

NOTICE TO USER:
