Later's Rotenone Flea Dust is Ready-to-Use and controls a wide range of insects. Rotenone is derived from the roots of the Derris plant and kills insects on contact and breaks down quickly.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Do NOT administer by mouth. To control American Dog and Cat Fleas, apply Flea Dust lightly to pet and rub down to work into skin. Apply lightly to Cats since too much dust can affect them. To control Fleas in and around premises, lightly dust the infested area, such as pet-bedding and sleeping quarters. Do not reapply product for 7 days. Treatment must only be repeated if pest problem reoccurs. Consult a veterinarian before using on sick, aged, pregnant or nursing animals or animals receiving drug or other pesticide treatment. Do not use on animals under 8 weeks of age. Discontinue use if adverse effects are observed. A veterinarian should be consulted when pest infestation continues to be a problem on the pet. Use ONLY in well-ventilated areas, preferably outdoors.

For effective Flea and Tick control, treatment of the pet must be combined with the clean-up and sanitation of any area used by the pet. Vacuum floors, carpets, furniture, etc. (discard vacuum bag after use) and wash the pet's bedding, living quarters and surrounding areas. If pest problems persist, an insecticidal premise treatment may be required.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid inhaling dust. After handling or applying, wash hands (or any other skin that came into contact with the product) with soap and water. Avoid contamination of food and feed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Toxic to Hogs. Do not use or store near Hogs. Toxic to fish and other aquatic life. Cover fish aquaria in the vicinity of treatment area. Do not contaminate lakes, ponds or streams.

FIRST AID: HUMANS

If swallowed, INDUCE VOMITING. To do so, give 2 glasses of warm water to drink and insert finger or blunt object into mouth and touch back of victim's throat. Contact a doctor or poison control centre IMMEDIATELY. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If in eyes,** flush with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention. **If on skin,** wash with plenty of water. Take container, label or product name and P.C.P. Reg. No. with you when seeking medical attention.

FIRST AID: PETS

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe the pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE: Keep product in original container. Store in a cool, dry place away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and discard with household garbage.
