This intermediate is designed for use in the manufacture of

insecticidal sprays, both liquid and pressurized. This product give a 1:2:3.3 proportion of d-trans allethrin:piperonyl butoxide:MGK 264. For example, this intermediate might be used at the rate of 0.556% (wt.) with 0.5% to 1.0% o- Isopropoxyphenyl methylcarbamate, or 0.5% O,O-Diethyl o-(2- isopropyl-6-methyl-4-pyrimidinyl) phosphorothioate, with approved solvents and propellents in the preparation of pressurized roach and ant sprays. Or, it could be used at the rate of 1.12% (wt.) in good refined base oil to product a space spray for small flying insects.

To be used only in the manufacture of insecticides which are registered with the Pest Control Products Act. Read the technical bulletin or product information for formulation details. This product is to be used with appropriate solvents and or carriers, and in the case of pressurized products, propellents, to produce an insecticide product.

MIX well in drum before sampling and each use.

PRECAUTIONS: Harmful if swallowed. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes.
