DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a herbicide that is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act* or a fertilizer-pesticide that is registered under the *Fertilizer Act*.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN AND UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Store with container tightly closed, and away from seeds, other pesticides, fertilizers, plants, foodstuffs and greenhouses. Protect from frost. Avoid contamination of ponds, streams, rivers and water sources. After use, wash hands and other exposed skin.

FIRST AID:

In case of skin contact, wash the affected areas thoroughly with cold water followed by a washing with soap and water or contact a poison control centre IMMEDIATELY.

In case of eye contact, wash the eyes with plenty of cold water, for at least 15 minutes, followed by a saline douche or contact a poison control centre IMMEDIATELY.

If swallowed, if patient is conscious, wash out mouth and give plenty of water. Get medical attention or contact a poison control centre IMMEDIATELY. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

No specific antidote. Employ supportive care. Treatment should be based on the judgement of the physician in response to reactions of the patient.

DISPOSAL:

Canadian formulators using this product should dispose of unwanted active ingredient and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations.

SPILL CLEAN-UP:

Keep by-standers away. Do not smoke, drink or eat during clean-up operations. Wear protective equipment (respirator, coveralls, rubber boots and protective gloves), and absorb the liquid onto soil, sawdust or other suitable absorbent material and shovel into a drum. Add broken packages to the drum and seal for removal to an approved disposal site. Wash spill site with water and mop up into a drum for disposal at an approved disposal site. Remove and wash all protective clothing and equipment. Shower and wash thoroughly with soap and water on completion of mopping up operation.
