DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Place one-quarter to one-half teaspoon at 2-3 m intervals of contents of this package in locations frequented by mice, or where mice have been known to feed. Bait must be protected from children, dogs, cats, poultry, livestock, etc. by bait boxes, cages or other suitable means. An uninterrupted supply of bait should be maintained for at least 10-15 days. Baits should be examined regularly and replenished before completely eaten. If bait moulds, decomposes or becomes sour it should be replaced. Where a continuous source of infestation prevails from nearby dumps or fields, permanent bait stations should be used and bait replenished as needed. Baiting should continue until complete lack of feeding is noted.
