PRECAUTIONS:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing dust, vapour, or spray mist. May irritate the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wear full face protection with cartridge respirator and chemical resistant gloves, apron, cap and boots when handling the concentrate. Do not wear contact lenses. Use only in well-ventilated areas.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention or contact a poison control center.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

If Swallowed: Call a physician or poison control center IMMEDIATELY. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention, or contact a poison control center.

Take container, label or product name and the Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

The following use levels (% by weight) re for Polyphase 641 addition to exterior and interior paints for dry film preservation. In order to determine the most cost effective use level for Polyphase 641 in a given use, field trials, performed within the label rate, are suggested.

EXTERIOR PAINT (SOLVENT): 0.5-1.5%

EXTERIOR PAINT (LATEX): 1.0-2.5%

INTERIOR PAINT: 0.2-0.8%
