A pyrethrin based, contact insecticide that kills both flying and crawling insects.

USE DIRECTIONS

To be effective, this product must be used at full strength.

Use in portable sprayers or foggers.

For the control of insects such as: Cockroaches, Ants, Flea Beetles, Fruit Flies, Lice, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Flies, Gnats, Sucking Lice, Ticks, Mites, Bedbugs.

FLYING INSECTS:: Close doors and windows. Using a portable

sprayer, direct spray-mist upwards to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources. Also direct spray-mist into areas where insects are present. Start at farthest corner of room and finish at doorway. For foggers, set to distribute 2 mL of product per m³ and apply at a rate of 170 mL per minute. If possible, keep doors and windows closed for 15-20 minutes after each treatment.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Spray hiding places such as baseboards, moist areas, openings around drains and pipes, and behind storage areas. Spray ant trails around door sills, window frames, or in ant nests. Insects must be hit to be killed. Apply at a rate of 15m² per litre. Apply a coarse spray moving the spray rapidly to prevent overwetting. Maintain proper ventilation after sealed areas have been treated.

In food processing plants and food service establishments, apply only when plant is NOT in operation. Remove all food before treatment. Cover all food processing surfaces and thoroughly clean with potable water before resuming operation.

For meat packing plants, treat only when plant is NOT in operation. No exposed meat products, ingredients or packaging materials to be kept in the room. Cover food handling equipment. All treated surfaces that may contact meat food products or other food products should be washed and rinsed thoroughly with potable water after treatment and before re-use for food processing.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Combustible liquid. Product contains petroleum distillate. Do not store, pour or use near fire or flame. Wear mask or respirator when applying spray mist. Wear protective clothing. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, etc. Do not contaminate feed, water or food stuffs.

FIRST AID: If in EYES: Rinse immediately with plenty of water. If irritation persists, seek medical attention. If on SKIN: Wash immediately with plenty of water. If irritation persists, get medical attention. If INGESTED: DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Have conscious person drink several glasses of water or milk. Seek medical attention or contact poison control centre. If INHALED: Allow the person to rest in a well ventilated area. If discomfort persists, seek medical attention.
