DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

1. Initial dosage for pool having no visible algae is 50 mL of ANTI-ALGUES per 10,000 L of pool water.
2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 25 mL per 10,000 L.
3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of EFFET-CHOC and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.

PRECAUTIONS:

- Keep out or reach of children.
- Harmful if swallowed.
- Do not mix with any other chemical.
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- Wear goggles and gloves when handling.
- Rinse container thoroughly before discarding. Do not reuse.
- To dispose of chemical, flush into sewer with large

quantities of water.
