**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

**Beef , Dairy Cattle (lactating and non-lactating) and Horses:** For best results use a sprayer adjusted to deliver the recommended amount of spray so that it will deposit uniformly on the animal's hair as a fine mist. The spray droplets should not be so coarse that they wet the hide, not so fine that they float away. 30 – 60 mL is enough for an adult cow. Take care not to spray in animal's eyes or mouth. Do not spray directly on udders. Wash udder before milking. Repeat as necessary but no more than once a day. Do not cover horses after treatment. If irritation appears, discontinue use.

**Wipe-on Method for Horses:** Apply with a cloth which is slightly moistened with the product. Use 30 – 60 mL for an adult horse. Repeat as necessary but no more than once a day. Do not cover horses after treatment.

**PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not breathe spray mist. If irritation appears, discontinue usage. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Do not contaminate feed, food or water. Contents toxic to fish and birds. Store in original container away from feed and food. Use only when milk room is NOT in operation. Cover or remove all milk and milking implements before spraying. After spraying, wash all surfaces that may contact milk and rinse thoroughly with potable water before resuming operations. This product contains a petroleum distillate at 98% (proportion by weight) which is moderately to highly toxic to aquatic organisms. . Avoid contamination of aquatic systems during application. Do not contaminate these systems through direct application. Dispose of waste or cleaning equipment.

**DISPOSAL:** Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.

**FIRST AID:** If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with clear water for 15 minutes; get medical attention.
