Directions for Use:

For preserving fence posts, planking, timbers, etc. Creosote gives protection against attacks of mildew, fungi, termites, rot and other wood destroying organisms.

Apply liberally with a brush. If the treated wood is to be used in contact with the ground or subject to other severe hazard or decay, apply a second coat after penetration of the first. Best penetration is obtained on properly seasoned dry lumber.

FOR EXTERIOR USE ONLY.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

Do not use creosote treated wood in residential interiors or

interiors of farm buildings.

Do not apply to wood where the preservative may come into direct or indirect contact with drinking water.

Keep out of reach of children.

Do not use creosote to wood intended for farrowing or brooding facilities or where domestic animals or livestock are likely to crib or lick the wood.

Do not apply to wood where the preservative may contact or become a component of food or animal feed.

Do not apply to wood where frequent or prolonged skin contact with the treated product is likely to occur.

Do not apply to greenhouse or horticultural lumber.

Do not apply to children's playground equipment.

Do not apply creosote to in situ structures (wharfs, docks) where contamination of open water may occur.

Do not spray or dip.

PRECAUTIONS:

Exposure to creosote can cause severe chemical burns to skin and eyes.

Wear gloves impervious to the wood treatment formulation in all situations where dermal contact is expected. Protective clothing made from the following materials has been found to be impermeable to creosote. Polyvinyl acetate, polyvinyl chloride, neoprene and NBR (Buna-N).

Wear protective clothing, coveralls, boots and hat.

Wear eye protection; (goggles).

Avoid inhaling vapors.

Avoid skin contact. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after exposure and before eating, drinking, use of tobacco products or using restrooms.

Do not eat, drink or use tobacco products during application process.

Do not burn treated wood.

Do not use near plants.

This product is toxic to fish.

FIRST AID

Skin Contact

Immediately remove soaked clothing or articles in contact with the skin.

Remove from skin with degrease hand cleaner.

Wash contaminated skin with soap or mild detergent and water.

Eye Contact

Immediately flush eyes with flowing water, occasionally lifting the upper and lower lids.

Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes.

Get medical attention.

Inhalation

Immediately move the exposed person to fresh air.

Apply artificial respiration if breathing has stopped.

Keep the affected person warm and quiet.

Get immediate medical attention.

Ingestion

Do not induct vomiting.

Never cause an unconscious person to vomit.

Get immediate medical attention.
