DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP PRODUCT OUT OF REACH OF UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Strictly observe all precautions for handling and using pesticides. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes and inhalation of dust. Wear protective clothing including, coveralls/apron, chemical resistant gloves, mask/face shield, goggles and boots when handling, mixing or loading this product. Use in well-ventilated area. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling product and before eating, drinking, or smoking. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and water before reuse. This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by the cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

The symptoms of mild poisoning from organophosphorus compounds are a feeling of exhaustion and weakness which may be accompanied by cramp-like abdominal pains, diarrhoea, excessive sweating, constricted pupils and salivation up to 24 hours after exposure. Severe poisoning can cause general muscle twitching and convulsions.

Azamethiphos is a Cholinesterase inhibitor. Antidote: Atropine under medical supervision. Inject 2 to 4 mg atropine sulphate (for children 0.5 to 2 mg according to age) i.v. or i.m. every 5 to 10 minutes until signs of atropinisation occur. The patient must remain atropinised for a sufficient length of time (24 to 48 hours) to prevent subsequent poisoning due to delayed resorption.

FIRST AID:
