AGRI-DORMANT EMULSIBLE SPRAY OIL is an emulsifiable type of mineral oil for use in the control of insect pests attacking apples, cherries, pears, peaches and plums.

### MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

The tank must be clean and equipped with agitation equipment. To mix, add water above the agitator and with agitator in motion, blend in the required amount of AGRI-DORMANT EMULSIBLE SPRAY OIL. The mixture should turn white which indicates good emulsification. Do not stop agitation until the spray tank has been emptied completely.
