### Background

Pounce Emulsifiable Concentrate Insecticide has been registered since August 13, 1980. Pounce Emulsifiable Concentrate Insecticide is registered for control of various insect pests on many food crops and fruit trees. For specific details of uses, application rates and methods, precautions, restrictions, and personal protective equipment requirements, refer to the product label.

### Purpose of Application

The purpose of this application is to amend the registration of Pounce Emulsifiable Concentrate Insecticide to include two new pests, for control of crucifer flea beetle on canola and European corn borer on potato. The proposed application rates are 90-180 mL/ha for control of flea beetle and 180 mL/ha for control of European corn borer. Both ground and aerial applications are proposed for the two pests.

### Chemistry, Health and Environmental Assessments

A chemistry assessment was not required since there was no change to product chemistry. Health and environmental assessments were not required since the use pattern of the component products remained unchanged.

### Value Assessment

The applicant provided rationale to support the proposed new uses, based on the existing use pattern registered for this product and some other similar products. Value assessment has been conducted and concluded that the proposed new uses (including application rate and method) conform to the registered use pattern of this product as well as other similar products

## **Conclusions**

The PMRA has completed an evaluation of the subject application and has found the information sufficient to amend the registration of Pounce Emulsifiable Concentrate Insecticide to include the proposed claims for control of crucifer flea beetle on canola and European corn borer on potato.
