Re: Notice of Objection – Chlorpropham RVD2008-01

Your notice of objection, filed under subsection 35(1) of the *Pest Control Products Act* (PCPA), regarding the re-evaluation decision for chlorpropham has now been received.

The purpose of a notice of objection is to identify the area of science supporting the registration decision to which objection is taken, to provide the scientific basis of the objection and to request that the area of science in question be referred to a review panel for reconsideration and recommendation. Notices of objection must be filed within the 60-day reconsideration period after a major regulatory decision has been published.

The re-evaluation decision for chlorpropham, RVD2008-01 was published in January 2008 and accordingly the reconsideration period for this decision closed in March 2008. Therefore, this letter is to notify you that your notice of objection regarding the re-evaluation decision for chlorpropham will not be considered since it was not received within the required timeframe.
